The Director, Lord Buddha Educational Society, NOIDA has applied for establishment of a Medical College at Raipur. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Chhattisgarh has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical College at Raipur.

It is certified that:-

- (a) The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded Hospital at Raipur.
- (b) It is desirable to establish a Medical College by Lord Buddha Educational Society, NOIDA in the public interest.
- (c) Establishment of Medical College by the Director, Lord Buddha Educational Society, NOIDA is feasible for 150 Students.
- (d) Adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Medical College as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the College with the permission of the Central Government.
